# Just A Little Walk Luke 24:13-35

Do you like taking walks? When was the last time you took one? I use to take walks; on the beach, in the woods. I use to walk home from school sometimes. Mom didn't like it. (Moms are always protective.) She was afraid I would get hurt. But it was just 2 miles. (Not 10 miles uphill, both ways in the snow!)

It was a good time to think. Walks are good thinking times. It is also a good time to let off steam. Walks are also a good time to talk with God.

Two men were walking; maybe home. Maybe on to a town for the next day's business. We really don't know. They were having a discussion about the events of the past few days when they met a third traveler.

He asked them about their discussion. "Don't you know?" they said. Astonished they asked, "Where have you been?" "Have you been living under a rock?!" I could imagine them saying. They chastise him for not knowing what happened to Jesus. Isn't it ironic they didn't realize it was Jesus.

When our children were younger and we were out walking, or traveling, I would get asked the question; "Did you see that?" or "Daddy, what is that?" And sometimes I would have to answer, "I didn't see it." Or "I don't know." It's because I was focused on the road and driving and I missed things around me.

Sometimes we miss things, don't we? We're looking elsewhere or concentrating on something else. If we were on that road to Emmaus would we have recognized Christ? Jesus told his disciples, "When I was hungry, you fed me; when I was thirsty, you gave me drink." "When did we do this?", they asked. "When you have done it to a member of my family, you've done it for me."

Did the two on the road to Emmaus expect to encounter Jesus?

If I asked you to describe your most profound encounter with Christ, what would it be like? Did you expect it? At times, it's when we least expect him, that we meet Jesus in the ordinary places and experiences of our lives. How do we know? We know. It's like that "burning within our hearts"

I don't know about you, but I could use a walk. A daily walk. I need to take a walk not only with my wife and my kids, but with Jesus. A walk to listen, to slow down and enjoy all He has to offer.


